Remember 2 Corinthians 4:5-6

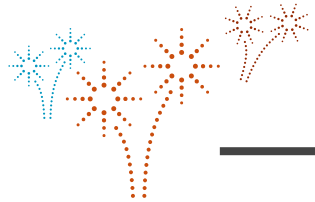
